



Cruise Itinerary for Parker Guide Service Sitka to Juneau
EXAMPLE OF POSSIBLE ITINERARY

Day 1: We will meet you when you arrive in Sitka. You will stay on the boat that evening in Crescent harbor in Sitka. Feel free to walk around and explore the history and beauty of what was once the capital of Russian America. Activities to choose from include Totem Park for totem pole viewing, Russian and Tlingit dancing, the Russian Orthodox church and the Russian Bishop Museum. Also available is the Alaska State Museum, offering the best array of Native artifacts in the state. We could also set up a private tour for you of our beautiful town.

Day 2 FISHING OPTION: Early breakfast at 6:45 am on board and go out salmon fishing on two 30 foot day boats between 7-8am directly from our yacht, the Alaskan Harvest moored in the harbor in Sitka. Fish Halibut and Salmon until approximately 12 or 4pm, depending on half or full day of fishing, and catch up Surges with the yacht which has now moved up in to Surgess narrows. Depart Sitka that evening while enjoying your dinner cruising along Surgess Narrows and Peril Straight. Possible Brown Bear, Sitka Deer, whale, and sea otter viewing, as well as kayaking. Anchor in a secluded calm cove for the night.

OR Cruise through Surgess narrows, wildlife viewing, hiking, beach combing, setting crab pots that evening. Everything above is included without the deep sea fishing. Salt water fishing is an additional cost if going for more than one day and must be taken near Sitka at the beginning or end of the trip depending starting point of your cruise. Freshwater fishing is included with the trip costs and is available in some ports of call.

Day 3: 7am a short cruise to Saook Bay for kayaking, beach combing, nature hike, and possible bear viewing & fresh water fishing. Early afternoon we will pull anchor and cruise to Hidden Falls salmon hatchery, observing whales and sea lions rookeries along the way. Possible brown bear viewing available. Kayaking in the early evening when anchored.

Day 4: 7am breakfast. Explore and take a tour of Hidden Falls Fish Hatchery. Back at the yacht by 10am. Pull anchor and cruise to Baranof Warm Springs. We will anchor or tie up at the dock of this quaint little town on the East coast of Baranof Island. You are welcome to take a dip in Natural hot springs right next to a raging river or enjoy the privacy of three public baths, while enjoying your view of snow capped peaks. Hike the trail to Baranof Lake and enjoy the huge

waterfall that sits right in the middle of town. Kayaking available if desired. We can stay here for the night or take a short 3-4 hour cruise to anchor in scenic Red Bluff Bay & Falls.

Day 5: 7am breakfast. 8am start your cruise by whale and sea lion viewing, enjoying Dahl porpoise as they play at the bow of the boat along your way to Pybus Bay on Admiralty Island. Enjoy your evening by Kayaking, bear viewing or hiking along the shores. Enjoy a campfire on a secluded beach while enjoying an Alaskan sunset.

Day 6: Start at 8am and cruise to Endicott Arm viewing sea life and kayaking along the way if desired. Explore Discover Cove and Ford's Terror.



Day 7:

7 :AM start. Cruise and explore North and South Sawyer Glaciers. Kayaking if desired or the 16ft. skiffs. End the day in Holkham Bay with a float plane ride to Juneau at approximately 4pm weather permitting. You will fly over the Juneau ice fields and be into Juneau by 5:30 pm. We are flexible on the itinerary and times of this package.
